

We understand the need for exceptional wrap-around care, providing a fully supervised Breakfast Club and After-School Club.

Breakfast Club

Our Breakfast Club provides essential support for todays' busy families, offering fully supervised care from 7.30am each weekday.

After-School Club

Our After-School Club offers a nurturing environment for children, including a sandwich tea and relaxation time for younger pupils, with collection from 5.30pm. For older children from Year 3, we provide care slots from 4pm to 5.15pm and 5.15pm to 6pm, including homework time and a hot supper in the later slot.

Day Boarding

Day pupils can experience boarding life, including evening routines, prep time, and activities, while returning home each night around 9pm. This option provides the benefits of boarding without the sleep-over, ensuring convenience.

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Your child's educational journey begins in Inglefield House, a nurturing and modern single-storey building designed specifically for our youngest pupils, from Nursery to Year 2.

Here, children are immersed in a world of engaging activities that spark curiosity and foster a love of learning. From hands-on lessons that ignite imagination to interactive experiences that build confidence, every day is an opportunity for discovery.

Music

Music is more than a subject—it's a joyful journey that inspires creativity, confidence and a lifelong love of learning. From their earliest years, every pupil's musical potential is nurtured and developed, with music placed at the heart of our curriculum.

Our bespoke Kodály-inspired programme blends playful singing and movement with listening, creating and composing. Our pupils develop exceptional musicianship skills while their innate, individual musical creativity is celebrated. The Kodály learning culminates through the opportunity to gain 'Gold Level Musicianship', a nationally-lauded opportunity rarely seen in junior schools and sets our pupils apart as skilled, independent musicians.

Music is celebrated throughout the year in services, concerts and productions, including our Eisteddfod and acclaimed school shows like Matilda. Every pupil is given the opportunity to shine, whether performing in ensembles or as soloists.

With specialist teaching and a vibrant, inclusive programme, we ensure every child discovers the joy and transformative power of music.



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Art and Design inspires our pupils to think differently, unlocking perspective, problem-solving and creative skills to explore a world where possibilities are boundless. Lessons encourage self-discovery, expression and individuality.

We immerse our pupils in workshops such as printmaking, graffiti, ceramics and more, building foundational skills for senior school and beyond. Each term brings exciting new topics, exploring historical and cultural influences, researching artists and movements and developing projects with diverse techniques. Group work, assessments, and trips to museums and galleries provide hands-on

learning, where pupils engage with artists and vibrant locations that bring their studies to life.

By the time our pupils leave, they're equipped with digital expertise, visual literacy and a confident art vocabulary—ready to connect their creative toolbox to academic subjects and the world around them.

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Languages

Language learning is a vibrant and enriching journey thanks to our specialist teachers.

From Reception to Year 4, pupils enjoy weekly French lessons that blend language and culture through songs, games and interactive activities, fostering an appreciation for the diversity of global cultures. Pupils also experience tasters of other languages, including Welsh, while KS2 lessons also incorporate linguistics to broaden their understanding further.

In Years 5 and 6, pupils advance to twice weekly French lessons, alongside Latin and Roman civilisation, which are brought to life through engaging stories, games and exploration of Roman history, myths and culture.

Cultural events, such as our annual Languages Day and Eisteddfod on St David's Day, celebrate linguistic diversity, while links with schools in Lyon, Frankfurt and Shanghai deepen international connections.

The Year 6 trip to France provides pupils with invaluable real-world opportunities to practise their French, instilling confidence and a love of languages that lasts a lifetime.

Advanced learning opportunities include maths enrichment sessions, the Revolutio Reading group (a KS2-senior collaborative project), National Science Quiz Club, regional and national music festivals, ISEB Project Qualification and our Prep School Diploma.

High standards in teaching and learning result in outstanding achievements, with annual academic scholarships awarded to pupils entering our senior school.

Notably, 25% of Year 6 pupils achieve a reading age of 17+ years.

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HabsMon (PSHE)

We help all our children to stay healthy, safe and prepared for life.

HabsMon, more commonly known as PSHE lessons, starting from Year 3, promotes healthy relationships, personal growth and preparation for life's challenges.

Weekly sessions, supplemented by expert-led RSHE (Relationship, Sex and Health Education) sessions for older pupils, help children develop positive, healthy relationships and navigate physical and emotional changes.



Science

Our science programme is a springboard for inspiration, led by our exceptional Doctor of Science. His bespoke curriculum transcends the English National Curriculum and Curriculum Cymraeg, cultivating curiosity and a lifelong love of discovery.

Our cutting-edge science lab and adjoining garden are dynamic spaces where pupils immerse themselves in hands-on learning. They design experiments, explore ecosystems and tackle real-world problems, honing critical thinking and problem-solving skills. Weekly features like the 'Last Week in Science' board and the collaborative 'Wonder Wall' bridge classroom lessons with global scientific advancements.

Beyond the classroom, pupils experience the wonder of science through enriching trips to Monmouth's Rockfield Studios and The Spaceguard Centre, as well as our celebrated Monmouth Science Fair. Success in national competitions, such as the National Science Quiz Club finals, highlights their growing confidence and capability.

We nurture innovative, inquisitive learners prepared to shape tomorrow's world.

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Computing

Computing is woven into our curriculum, providing pupils with the right skills for a technology-driven world. As a Microsoft Showcase School, we integrate cutting-edge digital tools into every subject, enhancing collaboration, creativity, and future-ready learning.

We encourage personalised learning through tools like Reading Coach, which helps pupils improve reading skills through tailored practice at their own pace. Pupils also use Flip videos in Teams Assignments to add creativity, deepen engagement and collaborate effectively empowering them to find, share and respect diverse voices.

Our forward-thinking approach ensures pupils are not just passive consumers of technology, but confident problem-solvers. From exploring ancient caves in Art

to designing with Minecraft or writing letters to Shakespeare, technology enriches every aspect of learning. Pupils develop transferable skills such as data analysis in Excel, teamwork on Teams and creating compelling presentations in PowerPoint.

This holistic integration of computing prepares pupils to innovate, adapt and lead, equipping them for success in an ever-evolving digital landscape.







Boarding
