Job Purpose	
<p>The Resident Sports Coach will play a key role in supporting the delivery of the School's Physical Education, Games and co-curricular sports programme, with particular responsibility for hockey and netball coaching. Working closely with the PE and Sports Faculty, the postholder will contribute to the day-to-day running of a dynamic sports department through lesson support, team coaching, fixture delivery and the promotion of sport, health and wellbeing across the School.</p> <p>The role offers an opportunity to develop coaching, teaching and pastoral experience within a thriving boarding environment, supporting students both in and beyond the classroom. The postholder will contribute to the wider life of the School, including co-curricular activities, weekend fixtures and boarding responsibilities, helping students to develop confidence, enjoyment and competence <u>in sport while supporting their overall wellbeing and personal development.</u></p> <p>Accommodation and food are provided as part of the remuneration package, as you will play an important role in supporting the well-being our boarding students, through the provision of co-curricular sessions and weekend fixtures in sport. You will have access to a gym and swimming pool on site, with opportunities for continuing professional development and training. Our coaches are assigned a mentor who will provide advice on professional development and working with students, both within and outside of the classroom. They will support and direct towards external CPD, including the possibility of coaching and officiating qualifications.</p>
